

2024 Benefits Changes

New Option:

Beat3 Plus

- Non-network option
- 25% Savings account available for day-to-day benefits
- R2,000 supplementary services benefit, per family per annum, used for listed day-to-day benefits prior to the savings account being utilized
- Optometry benefit paid from risk every 24 months, subject to Designated Service Provider
- 5 additional chronic conditions covered at 80% of Bestmed tariff from Non-PMB chronic benefit limit
- Listed preventative care benefits paid from risk

Key Benefit changes:

Enhancements

Rhythm

 IUD (Intrauterine device) INSERTION by a family practioner or network gynaecologist will be paid from risk – once every 5 years



2024 Benefits Changes

Enhancements continue:

Beat

- Papsmear the consultation fee of the Papsmear procedure will be paid from risk on Beat4
- IUD (Intrauterine device) INSERTION (consultation and procedure) by a family practitioner or network gynaecologist will be paid from risk once every 5 years on Beat2 and Beat3
- Out of Hospital Specialised Radiology: Added cover for 1 scan per lumbar and cervical spine region per beneficiary per year for conservative back and neck treatment paid from the available benefit (savings / day-to-day limit)

Pace

- Papsmear the consultation fee of the Papsmear procedure will be paid from risk across the Pace range
- Glaucoma screening: for beneficiaries 50 years and older 1 test per year at a network optometrist paid from the
 preventative care benefit on Pace2, Pace 3 and Pace4
- Out of Hospital Specialised Radiology: Added cover for 1 scan per lumbar and cervical spine region per beneficiary
 per year, for conservative back and neck treatment paid from the available benefit



2024 Benefits Changes

Benefit reduction:

Out of Hospital Specialised Radiology: MRI and CT scans reduced to 2 scans per beneficiary per year on Pace2,
 Pace3 and Pace 4

Provider changes for 2024:

- Netcare 911 will be the new emergency service provider
- Beat EDO and Rhythm hospital networks will be consolidated into one network.
- MediClinic and NHN (National Hospital Network) will replace the existing Netcare and Life Hospital networks. (confirm your hospital on Bestmed member app or Bestmed website)
 - "Filler" hospitals have been contracted to cover gaps in the network across all regions, including Life Healthcare, Netcare and other private hospitals
